To reach the campus from Interstate 81 (southbound and northbound):

Take Exit 118 to reach the exit ramps for all three of the exits. There is only one exit ramp serving the exits; missing the ramp means a trip north to Exit 128 or south to Exit 114 to turn around.

Take Exit 118B onto U.S. 460 West. This exit connects directly to the Christiansburg Bypass. Follow the signs for Blacksburg/Virginia Tech.

Due to construction in this area, there are lane and ramp changes. See the [information from VDOT](#) about the new U.S. 460 bypass between Blacksburg and Christiansburg.

Watch signs carefully for routes and directions. From the new bypass, Bus. U.S. 460 -- South Main Street, exits to the right (take South Main Street as one route to reach downtown Blacksburg). Stay on U.S. 460 West, signed for "Virginia Tech, Bluefield" to continue directly to the university.

Drive for 2.5 miles on U.S. 460 to the traffic light at VA 314, Southgate Drive. Turn right onto Southgate Drive. There is a [campus map](#) a quarter-mile on the right and the [Visitor Information Center](#) is a half-mile from U.S. 460 on the right.

To reach downtown Blacksburg, continue on U.S. 460 for about a mile to the Prices Fork Road exit for "Downtown." At the second traffic light on Prices Fork Road is access to campus via a right turn onto West Campus Drive. Prices Fork Road ends at North Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street to reach downtown proper.

For Harper Hall - most training is in the Seminar Room on the first floor. The parking is right outside of the building and overflow is just across the street. The students should go to the main Tech entrance at Southgate Drive and drive 1/3 mile to the Visitor's Center to get their temporary visitor parking passes. They should then get back on Southgate drive and take the immediate left onto Duck Pond Drive. Drive 1/2 mile and turn left on Washington Street. Drive another 1/3 mile to West Campus Drive. Harper Hall is the three story gray stone building on the right (looks new it is only two years old). The parking lot is on the left side of the building. If no spaces are available there, then people can look across the street at the two very large parking spaces behind that building (Litton-Reeves). They can get to those parking lots by backtracking to Washington Street and turning right into the lots. The entrance to Harper Hall is in the back of the building at the covered entry. The seminar room is the first room on the left on the first floor.

From the West --- Take Interstate 64 to Interstate 195 (Downtown Expressway/Powwhite Parkway) South. After going through the toll plaza (50 cents), follow the Powwhite Parkway to Midlothian Turnpike (Route 60) West.

**From the intersection of the Powwhite Parkway and Midlothian Turnpike (Route 60), go West through 4 traffic lights and turn right at the 5th light onto Robious Road. Turn right at the next light onto Old Bon Air Road and go about one mile until you see the second blue state sign. Turn right and you will see the Reception and Diagnostic Center immediately in front of you. Turn left and go to the stop sign. The next building on your right, outside the fence, is Cedar Lodge. Parking is available around the building outside of the fence.

Garner Room is in the modular section at the back of the building, accessible through the front entrance.

Maple Room is on the right of the lobby.

From the Southwest --- Take Route 360 past Brandermill to Route 288. Take Route 288 North to the Powwhite Parkway. Take the Powwhite Parkway to Midlothian Turnpike West. From this point, follow the directions above **.

From the East --- Take Interstate 64 West to Interstate 195 (Downtown Expressway/ Powwhite Parkway) South. After going through the toll plaza (50 cents), follow the Powwhite Parkway to Midlothian Turnpike (Route 60) West. From this point, follow the directions above **.

From the North --- Take Interstate 95 South to Interstate 195 (Downtown Expressway/ Powwhite Parkway) South. After going through the toll plaza (50 cents), follow the Powwhite Parkway to Midlothian Turnpike (Route 60) West. From this point, follow the directions above **.

Lost??? --- Look for the La Siesta Restaurant or the Sheraton Hotel on Midlothian. Both are near the intersection of Midlothian and Robious.

Directions via I-64:

Take I-64 to Charlottesville. Take Exit 118-B (Washington/ Culpeper exit). Stay in exit lane and exit onto U.S 29 Business (Fontaine Ave.). Turn right at bottom of exit ramp. Go to second red light (Maury Avenue) and turn left. Go straight through 4-way stop. You will then pass Scott Stadium on your right. Go to first red light (McCormick Road). Turn left. Proceed to stop sign. Turn right onto Edgemont Road. Drive past Environmental Health and Safety and the National Radio Astronomy Observatory. Virginia Transportation Research Council will be the next building on the right in the bend of the road (530 Edgemont Road).

The training will be held at the Virginia Transportation Research Council (also known as Shelbourne Building) at 530 Edgemont Road, Charlottesville, VA 22903. The training will be held in the VDOT Auditorium (enter front of building, go up the stairs; auditorium is to your right and well marked).

Visitor parking:

There is parking available at the Virginia Transportation Research Council building if needed. There are 20 spaces in front of the building and another 20-25 spaces in their back parking lot. Parking passes are not needed.

VDOT's Northern Virginia District headquarters building is located in the Avion Business Park, about one mile west of the Route 50 and 28 Interchange.

Directions

From I-66, exit at Rt. 50 West and continue approximately six miles. Turn right on Stonecroft Boulevard and right on Avion Parkway. Take your first right to access VDOT's parking lot.

From the Dulles Toll Road, take Route 28 South approximately five miles to Route 50 West. Turn right on Stonecroft Boulevard and right on Avion Parkway. Take your first right to access VDOT's parking lot.

From Richmond, take I-95 North to Route 123 North to Fairfax County Parkway North to Route 50 West. Continue approximately four miles and turn right on Stonecroft Boulevard and right on Avion Parkway. Take your first right to access VDOT's parking lot.

Parking

From Inter 95:

Take Exit 133 A to Route 17 toward Falmouth. Go straight through the intersection of Route 17 and Route 1 at Falmouth. There is a Volvo dealership on the right and a Woodstove Store on the left at this intersection. At this point, the road becomes Route 212, also known as Butler Road. Follow Butler Road to the first traffic signal and turn right; proceed to the next traffic signal and take a right toward the McDonald's; take a right at the edge of the McDonald's lot which takes you toward Chatham Square Office Park. Once inside the Office Park, take the second left. The Extension Office is in the last building on the left (#405).

From Culpeper (Route 3)

Follow Route 3 into the City of Fredericksburg (approximately 30 miles); continue on Route 3 East around the City of Fredericksburg (now called the Blue-Gray Parkway), over the Rappahannock River and into Stafford County; turn left onto Route 3 West (Kings Highway) at the traffic signal where the Blue-Gray Parkway intersects with Route 3 in Stafford County. Follow Route 3 West through 2 traffic signals; at the third traffic signal (just before reaching the Chatham Bridge), turn right onto Route 218 (White Oak Road); follow Route 218 to the traffic signal at the McDonald's on Butler Road; turn left at the traffic signal at McDonald's; take a right at the edge of the McDonald's lot which takes you toward Chatham Square Office Park. . Once inside the Office Park, take the second left. The Extension Office is in the last building on the left (#405).

From North of Richmond:

Take Interstate 95 South to Interstate 295 West. Take Interstate 295 to Interstate 64 West towards Charlottesville. Take Interstate 64 West to Exit 167 (Oilville - Goochland, Route 617). Take Route 617 South to Route 250 East. Go East on Route 250 about a quarter of a mile to Route 670; take a right onto Route 670 going towards Crozier. Take a right onto Route 6 at Crozier and go about two miles; the Academy is located on the right hand side of Route 6 across from James River Correctional Center.

From West of Richmond:

Take Interstate 64 East to Exit 159, Route 522. Take Route 522 South to Route 6 East. Follow Route 6 through Goochland; the Academy is on Route 6 on the left hand side across from James River Correctional Center.

From South of Richmond:

Take Interstate 95 North to Route 150 West (Chippenham Parkway). Route 150 will become Parham Road after crossing the James River. Take Parham Road to Route 6 (Patterson Avenue). Take Route 6 West heading towards Crozier/Goochland. The Academy is on the right hand side of Route 6 across from James River Correctional Center.

From East of Richmond:

Take Interstate 64 West to Exit 167 (Oilville - Goochland, Route 617). Take Route 617 South to Route 250 East. Go East on Route 250 about a quarter of a mile to Route 670; take a right onto Route 670 going towards Crozier. Take a right onto Route 6 at Crozier and go about two miles; the Academy is located on the right hand side of Route 6 across from James River Correctional Center.

Parking is available in the lot in front of the building. Check the board in the lobby for room assignment.

From Richmond & Eastern VA: I-64 West past Charlottesville. Take Exit 87 on to I-81 North. From I-81, take Exit 245 (Port Republic RD).

From Western VA: I-81 North to Exit 245 (Port Republic RD).

From Northern VA: I-66 West toward Front Royal. Take Exit 1A on to I-81 South toward Roanoke. Take Exit 245 (Port Republic RD).

At the exit from all directions, turn left off the ramp on to Port Republic RD. Proceed to Main and turn right; continue on Main for approximately 2 – 3 blocks. Go through the traffic light on Main (Kinko's on the right). Immediately after the light, turn left between Kyger & Trobaugh Funeral Home and Shenandoah Hall on to Patterson Street. From Washington, D.C. --- Take Interstate 66 West to Route 29 South, Lynchburg. Follow directions for Route 29 Southbound.

From Richmond --- Take Interstate 64 West to Route 29 South, Lynchburg. Follow directions for Route 29 Southbound.

From Petersburg --- Take US 1 South to Route 226 (Cox Road). Take Route 226 to Route 460 West. Take Route 460 West to Lynchburg Exit for Campbell Avenue/Route 501 South. Turn right at the end of the ramp onto Campbell Avenue. Go approximately 2 miles to and go straight onto Kemper Street (Campbell Avenue will bear off to the left). Take Kemper Street to Route 29 North. Once you cross the James River on Route 29, take the first exit (Route 210, Wright Shop Road/Central Virginia Training Center). Turn right at the top of the ramp onto East Route 210. Take the second right (at the light) and follow East Route 210 directly onto the CVTC grounds.

From Northern Shenandoah Valley --- Take Interstate 81 South to Interstate 64 East at Staunton. Take Interstate 64 East to the exit for Route 29 South, Lynchburg. Follow directions for Route 29 Southbound.

From Route 29 Southbound --- Follow Route 29 South to Madison Heights (Amherst County), taking care to remain on the main, divided highway. Do not exit onto or follow Route 29 (Business) South. Exit at Route 210, Wright Shop Road/Central Virginia Training Center. Turn left at the top of the ramp onto East Route 210. Take the second right (at the light) and follow East Route 210 directly onto the CVTC grounds.

From Danville --- Take Route 29 North. Once you cross the James River on Route 29, take the first exit (Route 210, Wright Shop Road/Central Virginia Training Center). Turn right at the top of the ramp onto East Route 210. Take the second right (at the light) and follow East Route 210 directly onto the CVTC grounds.

From Southwest Virginia --- Follow Interstate 81 North to the Interstate 581 South/220 South Exit. Merge onto Interstate 581 South. Exit at US 460 East/Orange Avenue. Follow 460 East to Lynchburg/Airport/Danville Exit. Turn left onto Route 29 North. Just beyond the shopping mall, right exit onto Route 29 North/501 South. Stay straight onto Route 29 North. Once you cross the James River on Route 29, take the first exit (Route 210, Wright Shop Road/Central Virginia Training Center). Turn right at the top of the ramp onto East Route 210. Take the second right (at the light) and follow East Route 210 directly onto the CVTC grounds.

FROM I-81, EXIT 47

- **(From I-81 South)** Turn left at the end of the exit ramp onto Highway 11/North Main Street.
- **(From I-81 North)** Turn left at the end of the exit ramp - continue to the stop sign and turn left onto Highway 11/North Main Street.
- Continue on Highway 11/North Main Street through 4 traffic lights.
- After you go through the 4th traffic light, turn left (beside Smokin' Joe's tobacco outlet)
- Continue up the hill (Marion Middle School will be on your right) to the yield sign.
- Turn right at the yield sign and proceed several hundred yards - the brick gates of SWVMHI will be on your left.
- Once you enter the gates, proceed to the stop sign and turn left onto Bagley Circle.
- Continue around the circle until you see the long, brick one-story Rehab Building on the left.
- Parking is available on both sides of the building.
- The classroom is located across the road in the basement of the auditorium (building with fenced/enclosed courtyard).

Approaching Petersburg:

- **From I-95:**
- As you arrive in Petersburg on I-95 from the north or south, take I-85 south towards Durham/Atlanta and go about 5 miles (Exit 63B)
- Exit onto Rt. 1 heading NORTH

- **From the east on 460:**
- As you near Petersburg (right after passing the I-295 interchange) you will come to a traffic light with a McDonald's on your right.
- Turn LEFT onto Wagner Rd.
- Take Wagner Road to I-95.
- Take I-95 north towards Richmond
- In Petersburg take I-85 south towards Durham/Atlanta
- Go about 5 miles
- Exit onto Rt. 1 heading NORTH (Exit 63B)

- **From the west on 460:**
- As you near Petersburg you will come to a traffic light and must turn. There will be an East Coast station on your left and a large brick church on your right.
- Turn left onto Route #1 heading north.
- Continue past I-85

From this point, all follow same directions

From I-85

- Heading north on Rt. 1 about ¼ mile past I-85 there will be a McDonalds on the left. There is an entrance to the campus on the right, but you don't want to turn here.
- Continue on US 1 until you come to a traffic light. US 1/Washington Street will curve to the right at the light (There is no straight. Just don't turn left.)
- There will be a white farmhouse on the left with a pasture. Prepare to turn left.
- The turning lane into the North Campus is just past the pasture and a hedge along the road. Turn left into the SVTC North Campus
- As soon as you turn in, you will see a parking lot on your right and a large one-story brick building with a gymnasium (Building 1). Parking should not be a problem. If the parking lot is full, there is more parking behind Bldg. 2 or on the hill.
- Come down the sidewalk between the two wings of the building and enter the lobby.
- Go left and continue all the way down the hall to the gym. If parking closer to the gym, just go in the doors at that end of the building.

Classes are in the gymnasium of Building 1.

From the North: Follow I-95 South to Exit 74B (Franklin Street). The James Monroe Building is the tall building on the right. Follow directions below to selected parking option.

From the South: Take I-95 North to Exit 74C. Follow Exit 74C, then take the Broad Street East ramp to the right. Turn right onto Broad Street. Go to the first traffic light that is N. 14th Street and turn left. Follow the directions below to selected parking option.

From the West: Take I-64 East. As you get into the central Richmond area, I-64 merges with I-95. Follow signs for I-95 South to Exit 74B (Franklin Street) (*do not get back onto I-64*). The James Monroe Building is the tall building on the right. Follow directions below to selected parking option.

From the East: Take I-64 West to I-95 South. Follow I-95 South to Exit 74B (Franklin Street). The James Monroe Building is the tall building on the right. Follow directions below to selected parking option.

Handicapped Parking

There are several spaces designated for the disabled on each of the three parking deck levels of the Monroe Building (entrance off N. 14th Street). An official handicapped parking license plate or decal must be displayed **and you must display a temporary parking permit** to avoid towing. Call DGS Parking Services, (804) 786-5675 at least one week before the event to purchase a temporary permit. The cost is \$2.

Public Parking

Parking is not permitted in State parking areas. Cars illegally parked in these areas are subject to ticketing and towing. Public Parking areas are available on nearby streets. Each of these streets is South of the Monroe Building. Although other parking facilities exist, the following are a few of the closest. The cost varies from lot to lot, usually between \$1.50 and \$5.00

1. Main and N. 14th Streets (AOPCOA Parking Lot)

Turn right onto Franklin Street off exit ramp. Go to N. 14th Street- turn left. Go one block to Main Street. See parking lot on left. (Small gravel lot.)

2. Cary off N. 14th Street (Public Parking Deck – AOPCOA)

Turn right onto Franklin Street off exit ramp. Go to N. 14th Street- turn left. Go two blocks to Cary Street. Turn left onto Cary. Parking deck will be on the left.

3. Cary and 15th Streets (VA Park – Value Parking Lot)

Turn left onto Franklin Street off exit ramp. At first corner turn right onto 15th Street. Go two blocks to Cary Street—turn left onto Cary. See parking lot on right corner.

4. Cary between 16th and 17th Streets (VA Park – Value Parking Lot)

Turn left onto Franklin Street off exit ramp. At first corner turn right onto 15th Street. Go two blocks to Cary Street—turn left onto Cary. See parking lot on right one block down.

To get to parking lots from Broad Street: Turn left onto N. 14th Street. Go two traffic lights to Main Street and see parking lot #1 on the left or go three traffic lights to Cary Street and turn left. Parking lots #2, #3, and #4 will be seen as indicated above.

From the south, I-81 N to I-581 South/U.S. 220 S exit toward the Airport/Roanoke. Once on I-581 South/U.S. 220 S, take the E. Hershberger RD exit (VA 101) toward the Airport. Turn right onto U.S. 11; then turn left on Plantation RD (VA 115). Turn right on Williamson RD (U.S. 11), which becomes U.S. 11.

From the North:

South on I-81 to Exit 225 Woodrow Wilson Parkway. Exit right onto 275W. At traffic light, turn left on US 11. Stay in the right lane and remain on Business 11 (Augusta Street) as you go into Staunton. You will go past the Post Office. Turn right on Oakenwold (before the library) and left into the Library parking lot.
